I am currently employed as Consultant in Burns and Plastic Surgery at the Queen Victoria Hospital East Grinstead, having taken up this appointment in February 2008. My Special Interests are in Burns and Lower Limb reconstruction and the surgical management of amputees. I also have a particular interest in scarring disfigurement relating to trauma and burn injury, and also manage acute burn injury patients. I have a special interest in burn injury in children and am actively involved in Child Protection Issues. I have significant experience in the management of lower limb injury including limb salvage and amputation management.

MEDICO-LEGAL EXPERIENCE

Since 2008 I have been involved with the preparation of Medico-Legal Reports and providing Expert Witness services for both Civil and Criminal proceedings. My main areas of experience are in

scarring, burns and lower limb injury. I have been involved in the legal process for many difficult child protection cases.

PLASTIC SURGERY TRAINING

I was trained in the UK Higher Surgical Training Programme in 3 main plastic surgery units: The Queen Victoria Hospital in East Grinstead, Royal Victoria Infirmary, Newcastle Upon Tyne and St Andrews Burn Centre, Broomfield Hospital Chelmsford.

I completed 5 years of general plastic surgery training including Burns, Skin Cancer, Hand Surgery, Breast Surgery and Soft Tissue reconstruction.

In 2006 I was awarded the McGregor Gold Medal for achieving top marks in the Plastic Surgery Fellowship Exam of the Royal College of Surgeons of England.

In 2007 I completed a six-month fellowship in Burn Care looking after acute burn injury and longer term reconstruction patients.

I have developed significant skills in the management of lower limb trauma and limb salvage. I am able to use a wide variety of techniques to resurface the lower limb to achieve soft tissue cover and save badly damaged limbs. However, I have also developed a significant experience in the management of amputation and the revisional surgery to lower limb stumps to improve the fitting of prosthetics and assist in mobilisation after major trauma.

Military Plastic Surgery Training

I have undergone significant training since taking up my consultant post in military aspects of plastic surgery. This has included secondments to the clinical team in Birmingham, and specialist courses in military operational surgical techniques as well as other pre-deployment training for Afghanistan.

CAREER AIM

I have now achieved my aim to become a military Plastic Surgeon, maintaining my special interests in burns and trauma reconstruction, and now work between Queen Victoria Hospital in East Grinstead and the Defence Rehabilitation Centre at Headley Court.

I plan to continue to work in a busy Burns Centre looking after patients with acute burns, planning long term rehabilitation and being actively involved with the training of all levels of military personnel in the prevention and management of burn injury. I hope to continue to work with the British Burn Association to ensure that all deploying personnel have access to a military run Emergency Management of Severe Burns Course and update training where appropriate. I would also like to continue my interest in lower limb trauma, heterotopic ossification and microsurgery, working to provide optimal long term care for injured soldiers.
